GUITAR HERO CONTEST OFFICIAL RULES

1. Scoring will be based on the highest scores listed on www.scorehero.com, an independently owned and operated website. Contestants ranking score will be a percentage of the highest score listed for the song and skill level chosen.

Example: Freebird		
Highest Score / Skill Setting	Contestant Score	Ranking Score
313,702 Easy	120,000	38.253%
442,158 Medium	125,000	28.270%

Above, the person playing on Easy scored a better % of the max points than the person on medium, so they would win. Scoring will be kept track of by the even host. NOTE: Any player bypassing the scoring screen before the score is logged will forfeit their score.

2. The contest will be held as a SOLO contest, using Guitar Hero - World Tour on a PlayStation 2 game console, No playing on Career mode, changing characters, guitars etc. You may not bring your own equipment or enter any cheat codes.
3. For effectiveness of the contest, the Qualifying round will be limited to 40 entrants. The top 8 players during the qualifying event will be selected for the finals to compete that evening.
4. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 places in the finals.
5. Contestants must register prior to the event. Onsite registration will begin at 10am and end at 10:45am. E-Mail and Postal Mail must be received by the evening of Monday July 13th, 2009. Those choosing to pre-register must bring a completed copy of the registration form to the event to verify acceptance of contest rules.
6. Guitar Hero has an ESRB rating of "T" for TEEN. Because of this rating, children under the age of 13 are permitted to enter the contest only with signed parental permission on the registration form.
7. Qualifying will start at 11am and run until either 4pm or all contestants have played 1 song.
8. Finalists need to be at the stage by 7:15 to ensure a timely start. The finals will start at 7:30 PM
9. Contestants for the Qualifying round may choose to play on either hard or expert skill.

10. ALL Finalists, will compete on expert mode for the finals. The contestants song will be selected at random from the below list of songs.

In the event of a tie - Guitar Hero 3 will be used and Through the Fire and Flames will be the played by both contestants.

12. Anyone blatantly damaging any of the equipment will be financially responsible to replace the broken equipment.

13. Anyone found violating these rules will be disqualified.

14. Rules are subject to change/be amended as needed, any amendments to the rules shall be posted at the event.
